Rocky Mountain SER is a community based non-profit organization, which has provided education, employment, and training services to underprivileged families throughout the state of Colorado, for the past three decades.

Rocky Mountain SER's Early Childhood Education Division is the largest in Region VIII. Providing educational services in a total of 18 communities throughout the State of Colorado, serving a total of 2,276 children and their families. In addition, since the spring of 2012; RMSER has provided early childhood education to families involved in our Migrant and Seasonal Farmworkers program.

The Workforce Development Division services migrant and seasonal farm workers through a one-stop workforce development center in 20 communities throughout many rural counties in Colorado. The 167 National Farmworker Jobs Program is solely offered by RMSER throughout Colorado. As the federal grantee of this program, RMSER offers employment, training and support services to low income migrant/seasonal farmworkers.

Season for Giving is an annual Christmas gift program established in 2010. The program is solely supported by volunteers and sponsors. Since 2010 thousands of children served by RMSER, along with their families have had their Christmas wishes come true through the generosity of our donors. RMSER has helped thousands of children and families over the past 35 years to enhance their lives and increase their self esteem and sense of belonging.
